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Dental Guidelines During Pregnancy

During your pregnancy we recommend that you continue with your regular dental cleaning and exam visits but **DO NOT** have the common diagnostic x-rays performed at these visits. **X-rays may only be taken if necessary for an emergent reason and if the abdomen and pelvis is completely covered with an X-ray shield.**

The following is a list of acceptable and contraindicated medications that may helpful for your dentist in your dental care. Please take this list with you to your dental appointments.

Acceptable

Ampicillin

Erythromycin

Flagyl

Amoxicillin

Vicodin

Tylenol 3

Percocet

Procaine (Novocaine)

Contraindicated

Ciprofloxacin

Gentamycin

Tetracycline

Doycycline

Valium (all sedatives)

Motrin (all NSAIDs)

Nitrous Oxide
